### REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT STATUS REPORT

The Regional Transportation Council identified several priority transportation projects and initiatives for the region. Staff will summarize the progress and next steps for 10 selected transportation opportunities for improving mobility and air quality in the region. Several projects like S.H. 161, strategic partnerships, regional rail and Air North Texas are moving forward.

### TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM MODIFICATIONS

The TIP is a staged, multi-year listing of surface transportation projects proposed for funding by federal, State, and local sources within the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area. The TIP contains projects with committed funds in current and future fiscal years. Quarterly modifications to projects within the TIP help to maintain accurate project listings. Project listings are financially constrained to available resources. The latest set of quarterly project modifications will be presented for public review and comment.

### UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP) MODIFICATIONS

The UPWP for regional transportation planning provides a summary of the transportation and related air quality planning tasks conducted by the Metropolitan Planning Organization. Modifications to the Fiscal Year 2008 and Fiscal Year 2009 Work Program will be presented.

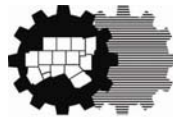
